These cabinets are suitable for use in hospitals, clinics, laboratories, and emergency vehicles, including ambulances where secure morphine storage is critical.

Manufactured from robust materials and finished in white epoxy powder coating for ease of cleaning and infection control, all cabinets are built for long-term performance. Standard models are supplied with BS3621-compliant locks and two keys as standard, with options available for enhanced security through Euro lock, dual Euro lock, or four-lock configurations.

Clinical Reagent Cabinets are supplied with cam locks, and sizes are available beyond those listed as part of the standard range to meet specific clinical needs.

These cabinets ensure that controlled drugs remain accessible to authorised personnel only, while maintaining full regulatory compliance and supporting safe medical practice.
